

Process to Sign Up for Reverse 911

In times of crisis, the sooner we are alerted to a situation or danger, the sooner we can efficiently respond.

In order to be automatically notified in case of a county-wide or local emergency through the Reverse 911 system operated by the Butte County Office of Emergency Management (25 County Drive, Ste 200, Oroville 95965; 538-7373), you must have a listed land line phone, in which case you will already be included in the system.

If you do not have a land line phone or have an unlisted number and/or would like to have your cell phone or unlisted land line number included in any notification call during trouble, you can register by taking the following steps:

- ◆ Go to the **Butte County** web site: <http://buttecounty.net/>
- ◆ Go to “**Emergency Notifications**” on the left side, listed under “**Quick Links**”
- ◆ **Fill out** the requested information and **submit** it
