INTRODUCTION

This course articulation guide outlines many of the Butte College classes that Hearthstone students may enroll in through the concurrent enrollment program for core course and elective credits. Our goal is to provide teachers, parents and students a document to help students select the most appropriate classes at Butte College should the student desire to earn high school and college credit for the classes through concurrent enrollment. The guide provides class information at a glance, including the type of high school credits a student can earn for each class. Noted is which classes are UC and/or CSU transferable. This document is a companion to the Butte College Course Catalog, which includes descriptions and the pre-requisites required by the college to attend each class.

The process of developing this articulation included reviewing the California State Standards and matching these standards to the course content in each course. We reviewed the Butte College Catalog as well as all course outlines that we could find online through the Butte College website. While many of the Butte College classes are higher-level academic classes than standards-aligned high school courses, our responsibility was to correlate Butte College classes that would be equivalent to high school courses in terms of general breadth of knowledge embodied in the state standards. Some BC classes were assigned elective credits due to the specificity of content, while others were assigned elective credit due to the fact that BC course requisites would require students to take a general course first which would 'count' for core course credits.

Although we have attempted to make this a comprehensive document, the classes listed in this document are those most often attended by our students. *If a student would like to enroll in a class not listed in the guide, please contact the principal to determine the articulation and add the class to the guide prior to enrolling in the course.* We also encourage you to share any ideas related to how to make this document more useful for students in selecting appropriate classes at Butte College. We hope this information will be helpful to students who would like to attend Butte College classes while they are enrolled and taking courses at Hearthstone School.
