## CALIFORNIA MINI-CORPS WORKSHOP POLICY

The Mini-Corps Program requires that participants of the program attend a minimum of six (6) hours of monthly training sessions scheduled by the program coordinators and/or administrators. The mandatory workshops are scheduled at different times in the twenty-four college sites. If a participant is unable to attend a workshop, he/she must:

1. Attend, on a monthly basis, alternative educational workshops with coordinator /administrator approval that are equivalent to six (6) hours for each Mini-Corps workshop that he/she does not attend. The alternative training can be provided by the school or district where the Mini-Corps student is working, by the county office of education or by a professional area conference.
2. If unable to attend Mini-Corps workshops which are regularly held on Saturday, due to religious beliefs, the Mini-Corps participant must submit a note from the church or minister stating that he/she cannot attend Saturday workshops. In this case, the student and the college coordinator/administrator will arrange for alternative workshops.
3. Provide to the program coordinator/director verification of attendance at the alternative educational workshop program(s) by submitting a copy of the training agenda with the presenter's signature attesting the student's participation at the workshop.
